RE: Monthly Police Activity Report – November 2024

The Town of McCandless Police Department responded to 877 calls in the month of November.

During the month of November, several officers attended training. One officer went to Troy Armorer to learn to care for our Troy patrol rifles. Another officer attended a class titled Integrating Communications and Assessment – which teaches several techniques for tactical verbal de-escalation during highly intense situations.

Our newly hired officers are nearing the end of their field training. Two of them are expected to be released at the beginning of December and the other towards the end.

McCandless Police participated in a statewide effort to enforce the use of seatbelts. November 20, 2024 we assigned one officer to this detail for four hours. He conducted four traffic stops and issued four warnings and four citations.

The officers assigned to the North Hills SRT and K9 Officer Davis and Siraly attended their monthly training.

Detective Sergeant Eric Egli was promoted to Lieutenant on Monday, December 11, 2024 at the Town Council meeting. We wish Lieutenant Egli well in his new role here at McCandless Police.

Lieutenant Egli conducted an active shooter response presentation at Remington Personal Care home for staff members on November 20, 2024.

The department assisted North Allegheny School Police while conducting lockdown drills.

Our team completed social worker interviews. Ms. Jennifer Frye will begin as the McCandless Police Social Worker on Monday, December 9, 2024.
